Session 1: **Myths and Legends**

Ages: 5-11

Dates: June 6th- 10th

Mythical creatures, mermaids and monsters come to life in the imaginations of the kids! We'll study legends—real and mythic—and make awesome projects that help you transform your imagination into vibrant entry level pieces of art.

Session 2: **Outer Space**

Ages: 5-11

Dates: June 13th- 17th

This week's theme focuses on art projects with subject matter revolving around space. Aliens, spaceships, other planets and endless possibilities will be explored through entry level art projects.

Session 3: **Advanced Projects for Teens**

Ages: 12-18
