

***PRAXIS* Information for Music Education Students**

1. PRAXIS I: CORE ACADEMIC SKILLS FOR EDUCATORS (*CASE*): READING, WRITING, and MATH – University of Louisiana System minimum passing scores are required for admission to all Teacher Education Programs (Teacher Candidacy), including Alternate Certification:

5712 Reading Test: 156 (\$90)

5722 Writing: 162 (\$90)

5732 Math: 150 (\$90)

5751: Combined Test (All 3 parts - \$150)

(An ACT composite score of 22 or an SAT combined verbal/critical reading and math of 1030 may be used in lieu of *CASE*.)

2. PRAXIS II Content Tests: A passing score/s on the test/s in the music content area K-12 is required for admission to all Alternate Certification programs OR for acceptance to Student Teaching.

Music: Content Knowledge (0113 or 5113) 151 (\$120)

3. PRAXIS II Principles of Learning and Teaching test – A passing score is required for admission to Student Teaching. (\$146)

5624 Principles of Learning and Teaching: K-6 157
